Online Safety Ambassadors

Stay safe when posting videos online by:

- Use cartoon face for profile picture, rather than your real face
- Make up a username rather than using real name
- Set the privacy settings to friends only, not public
- Don't wear clothes in videos that could identify you or where you go to school or what clubs you go to
- Never sharing your location

When receiving messages online, in games for example, beware of people who try to:

- Bribe you
- Persistently contact you
- Send you spam
- Threaten you
- Are unkind to you

- Only add 'friends' who you know in real life
- Don't send a message or write a post that might upset or humiliate somebody
- Only share appropriate content online
- Think about how your online behaviour effects other people
- Don't share your passwords with anyone. If you think someone knows your password, change it
- Never meet up with people you meet online
- If you see anything online that upsets you, talk to an adult who you trust
