

Wraparound Care Provision

Now that we are a few weeks into the year and children have settled into their new routines, we are in the process of exploring (via ParentMail survey) the viability of soon reinstating wraparound care provision.

Guidance from the DfE says that where it is not practical to maintain the same bubbles being used during the school day, wraparound care provision should take the form of a small, consistent group. As a small school, this would apply to us. Therefore, we are seeking to establish if there is sufficient demand from families who would use **daily** wraparound care at this time.

Being a larger space, provision would take place in the hall (as well as outdoors when possible), with children being dropped off and collected from the main gate. Parents would press the ASC doorbell upon arrival and refrain from entering the school site.

If you would use Breakfast Club and/or After School Club provision on a **daily** basis (to help us keep the group small and consistent), please complete the ParentMail form by 23rd September.

Phonics Information

We will shortly be sending out information to parents of children in Year 1 about the phonics check next June. The DfE have confirmed that they will be asking schools to assess Year 2 phonics levels this term, as the pupils missed out on last year's check. Please continue to read lots at home.
