## PE and Sports Premium 2019 – 2020

*Updated: November 2019, February 2020; October 2020 (Final)*

**Total Grant: £17,244**

The purpose of this document is to explain how Beckley School intends to spend the PE and Sports Grant for the 2019 – 2020 academic year.

OCC Guidance on how to use the grant:

*The following is included to provide schools with guidance as to how they can use the PE and sport premium*

*Schools must use the funding to make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE and sport they offer.*

*This means that you should use the premium to:*

- *develop or add to the PE and sport activities that your school already offers*
- *make improvements now that will benefit pupils joining the school in future years*

*For example, you can use your funding to:*

- *hire qualified sports coaches to work with teachers*
- *provide existing staff with training or resources to help them teach PE and sport more effectively*
- *introduce new sports or activities and encourage more pupils to take up sport*
- *support and involve the least active children by running or extending school sports clubs, holiday clubs and Change4Life clubs*
- *run sport competitions*
- *increase pupils' participation in the School Games*
- *run sports activities with other schools*

*You should not use your funding to:*

- *employ coaches or specialist teachers to cover planning preparation and assessment (PPA) arrangements - these should come out of your core staffing budgets*
- *teach the minimum requirements of the national curriculum - including those specified for swimming (or, in the case of academies and free schools, to teach your existing PE curriculum)*

## PE and Sports Premium Plan

The funding allocation is £16,000 plus £10 per pupil in Years 1 – 6.

*Note: CPD opportunities have been focussed on the areas that staff feel less confident teaching.*
